

PRESENTERS/DISCUSSION LEADERS

Peter Clay, a member of the Des Moines Valley Friends monthly Meeting, will lead a query discussion with longtime IYMC members and newer active members/ attenders of IYMC monthly meetings.

Peter Blood began life in Oskaloosa and was deeply involved in nonviolent resistance to the Vietnam War. He and his wife Annie Patterson worked with Pete Seeger to create the songbooks *Rise Up Singing* and *Rise Again* as ways to build community and a better world. He is currently creating an online library (Inwardlight.org) to help people learn how revolutionary Quakerism is—from its beginnings to the present day.

J.J. Kapur is an AmeriCorps fellow serving with CultureALL, a Des Moinesbased non-profit dedicated to valuing the cultures of our community.

John Zimmerman is director of Scattergood Friends School and Farm. He works with students and staff to identify how best to merge the wisdom gained from our first century of Scattergood Friends School with the needs and expectations of today's students and the generations yet to come. He has also an extensive career in community and professional theater.

Angelika Shafer, originally from Germany, has been a member of Northern Yearly Meeting and now clerks Penn Valley Meeting in Kansas City. She is a caregiver and activist. She and her husband Jon live in Kansas City.
